

EAST ANTRIM BOAT CLUB

Application for use of Club premises

Use of Club premises with or without bar facilities is granted only when a Family or Full Club member or when a registered charity is named on the application.

The person named on the application must be over 18 years of age and must be present for the duration of the function and shall be responsible for ensuring that those attending a function where bar facilities are required are over 18 years of age and that persons under 18 years of age do not enter the bar area or consume alcoholic beverages also that those attending the function comply at all times with the Club Rules regarding conduct. A copy of the Rules is available from the Hon. Secretary. If any damage is caused to Club property, either inside or outside the Clubhouse, the person named on the application will be held liable for any costs to East Antrim Boat Club and in making good the same.

Deposit of £50 is required to secure a booking of the club for Functions, the deposit will be returned if the Bar Sales cover staff and facility costs, these costs are determined by the General committee and will be advised on booking. **Charity's are not required to provide a deposit.**

Members have the right to use the full facilities of the Club and to be on Club premises at all times.
