### NOTICE OF RACE

#### 1 RULES

- 1.1 The regatta will be governed by the rules as defined in *The Racing Rules of Sailing*.
- 1.2 The prescriptions of the RYA will apply.

#### 2 ELIGIBILITY AND ENTRY

- 2.1 The regatta is open to boats of the GP14 class.
- 2.1 All boats shall have a valid Class Certificate of registration and measurement issued prior to the commencement of this event.
- 2.2 Each helm must be a paid-up member of the GP14 Class International Association.
- 2.3 Eligible boats may enter by completing the entry form on arrival at the club, together with the required fee of: £50.00
- 2.4 Registration and payment of entry fee should be made on-line at East Antrim Boat Club website ([www.eabc.club](http://www.eabc.club)) before Saturday 20<sup>th</sup> May but preferably by 1800hrs on Thursday 18<sup>th</sup> May 2023.

#### 3 SCHEDULE

- 3.1 Registration will be online at [www.eabc.club](http://www.eabc.club) prior to the event
- 3.2 6 Races are scheduled:
  - Saturday 20<sup>th</sup> May – up to 4 races
  - Sunday 21<sup>st</sup> May – up to 4 races
- 3.3 The scheduled time of the first warning signals will be:
  - Saturday 20<sup>th</sup> May 1200hrs
  - Sunday 21<sup>st</sup> May 1100hrs

#### 4 SAILING INSTRUCTIONS

#### 5 PRIZES

Prizes will be given as follows: 1st, 2nd and 3rd Gold Fleet 1st, 2nd and 3rd Silver Fleet 1st, 2nd and 3rd Bronze Fleet

*Association Trophies shall be held by the winners and returned by them (in good time and in good order) to the Organisers of the event in the following year. The winners shall be responsible for engraving the trophies. Any GP14 Association Trophies presented shall not be removed from Ireland.*

## **6 DISCLAIMER OF LIABILITY**

Competitors participate in the regatta entirely at their own risk. See rule 4, Decision to Race. The organizing authority will not accept any liability for material damage or personal injury or death sustained in conjunction with or prior to, during, or after the regatta.

## **7 INSURANCE**

Each participating boat shall be insured with valid third-party liability insurance with a minimum cover of £3,000,000 Pounds Sterling or the equivalent.

## **9 CATERING**

- Competitors are responsible for providing their own food and drink.
- A buffet style dinner (£15 each) has been arranged for 1830hrs on Saturday 20<sup>th</sup> May. So that the caterer can plan for numbers, competitors and accompanying family and friends are requested to order online by 1830hrs on Friday 19<sup>th</sup> May. Payment for this should also be made online by this date.
- Refreshments will be provided to all competitors on the Sunday
- Coffee and snacks will be available onshore throughout Saturday and Sunday
- Two external drinking water replenishment taps are available at the patio area of the clubhouse.
